cozy and traditional inn. Next morning navigate the lunar landscape of the Bernina pass and enter Italy. Now you are on the spur of Andreas Hofer, an early 19th century idealist and a Tyrolean hero. Climb countless twisties to the grand pass of all passes known by mere mortal riders as the Stilfser Joch/Passo dello Stelvio.

Your riding activities are not only curve-twisting, but tongue-twisting as well, trying to pronounce all the passes you'll come to know and love! Not only are exciting rides every day, but new adventures in taste are waiting for you at your dining table. Try Swiss Raclette or Fondue, the best Alpine pasta in Italy or Tyrolean Speckknoedel.

Innsbruck with its Goldenes Dachl of Emperor Maximilian. Or you can visit King Ludwig's 19th century fairy-tale castles, Neuschwanstein and Linderhof, or the beautiful Wieskirche. Perhaps you will also believe, as the Bavarians do, that their Ludwig wasn't so crazy after all!

Enter Germany and enjoy a stretch of Autobahn through the Allgau and Bavaria landscapes. Cross the Danube river. Enter Franconia and enjoy country roads to a fairy-tale stay in the medieval Rothenburg ob der Tauber, the best-preserved fully walled town in Europe. Walk ramparts and cobbled streets. Climb the Old Town Hall for spectacular views and roof angles.

Ride the trail of Count Goetz von Berlichingen, who supported the peasant revolts of the 16th century and received an iron hand and dungeon stay for his efforts. Or if you'd like, visit the motorcycle museum at Langenburg and ride the Odenwald forest.

Explore the scenic Neckar river valley as it meanders through quaint and colorful wine villages to the Student Prince university town of Heidelberg. See the grand castle and visit the Altstadt (Old City). Your tour is almost over as you mount your steed one last time, ride the cobblestone streets and enter the Autobahn for a short and fast ride towards Frankfurt/Main.

Start your ride by winding along the Rhine river and through the vineyards and hills of Rhinehessen. Curves slowly start with open meadows, green valleys and pine trees of the Black Forest. Cross over into Switzerland. If you like, visit Bettwil with the museum and garage of Fritz Egli, a well-known engine tuner and frame constructor. Savor the quiet lapping waters of the Vierwaldstaetter See and its crowned jewel of Lucerne.

Explore the wood-carvers village of Brienz. How about scaling heights with the Brienz Rothorn Bahn on a steam powered cog-gear train for an incredible Alpine view? Or why not greet the Swiss passes Susten, Grimsel and Furka? The peaks and valleys seem to call out your name as you challenge them.

Over 25 passes introduce themselves to you over the course of your travels in the Grison and Engadin regions of Switzerland, Dolomites of Italy, Tyrol and Vorarlberg areas of Austria. Climb to 8,000 feet, streak through a valley and rise once again.

See the Rhone glacier. Climb the Oberalp pass to the Rhine river source. Challenge the passes Spluegen, Albula or Julier. Stay in a

Ride narrow roads and sample your first drafts of the Dolomites air, as you complete a loop on the Sella and Pordoi Joch. Ride the Passo di Costalunga or 10 others of your choice! Enter Austria through the back door and see the wild horses at the Timmelsjoch. Ride carefree through villages and meadows. The roads you ride will never be forgotten!

At your 2 day stop in Tyrol, see the Olympic city of
